#### **Centennial of what?**

- The academic year 2015-16 marks the centennial of the first class:
  - UBC both accepted students and graduated them as alumni
  - In 1915 degree courses were three years long
  - the first class included students who had already completed two years at McGill College of BC
  - Thus the Centennial celebrates UBC <u>students and alumni</u> in one symbolic year.

## Who is the target for the Centennial?

#### 1. UBC Community:

- 300,000+ living alumni and donors.
- 55,000 current students/alumni-in-waiting
- 14,000 faculty and staff, 30% of whom are alumni
  - UBC is the #1 employer of UBC alumni!
- Faculty emeriti/retirees

#### 2. Influencers:

- Families of students/alumni
- Research and business communities
- Federal and Provincial governments
  - Federal election is slated for October 19, 2015
  - Provincial election May 9, 2017
- 3. General public in Vancouver, Okanagan, BC and ROC
